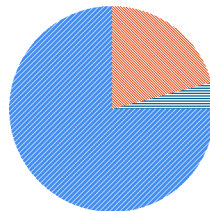

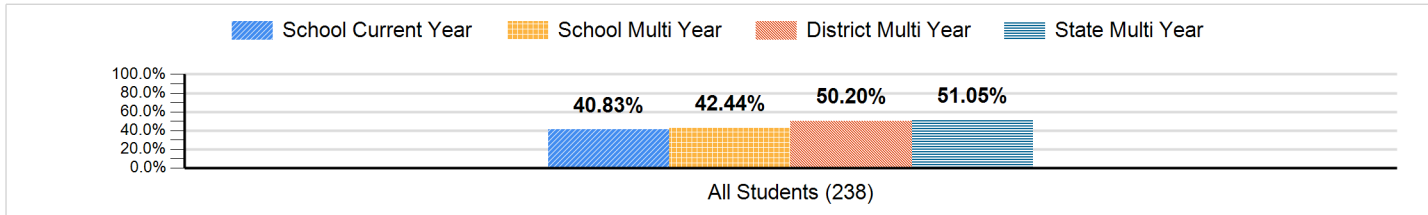
**Student Population**

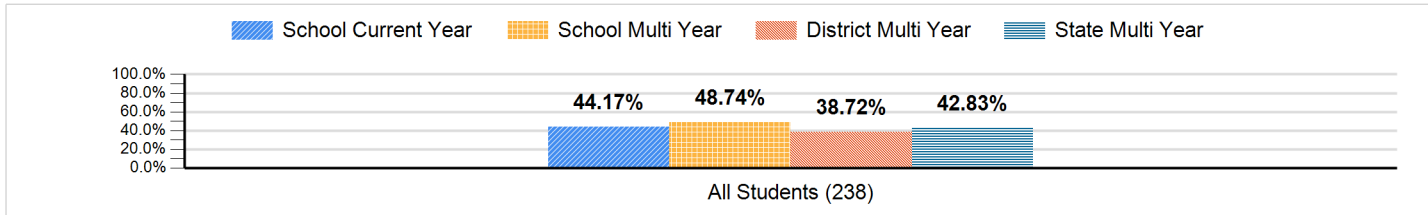
