ARP ESSER Plan Requirement Updates

- District safe return plan is available for translation upon request.
- Wagner Community School District collaborates with state, local and tribal health officials and reports contract tracing data.
- Wagner Community School District has coordinated three vaccination clinics that were held on school campus. We will continue to advertise and support such clinics.

The district ARP ESSER III document on the school website identifies our continuity of services.

-Student academic needs: Additional staff hired including interventionists for both the elementary and middle schools. Multi-Tiered Systems of Support is utilized to identify and support students with academic/behavior concerns.

-Student social, emotional, and mental health needs: The school employs three full-time licensed counselors. In addition, the school has a partnership with the regional Lewis and Clark Behavioral Health Services to provide additional student support

-Staff members' social, emotional, and mental health needs: School administration will support when needed.

-Food services: Wagner Community School is dedicated to provide every student the opportunity to receive breakfast and lunch on scheduled days of instruction. Accommodations will be made if mode of instruction changes
