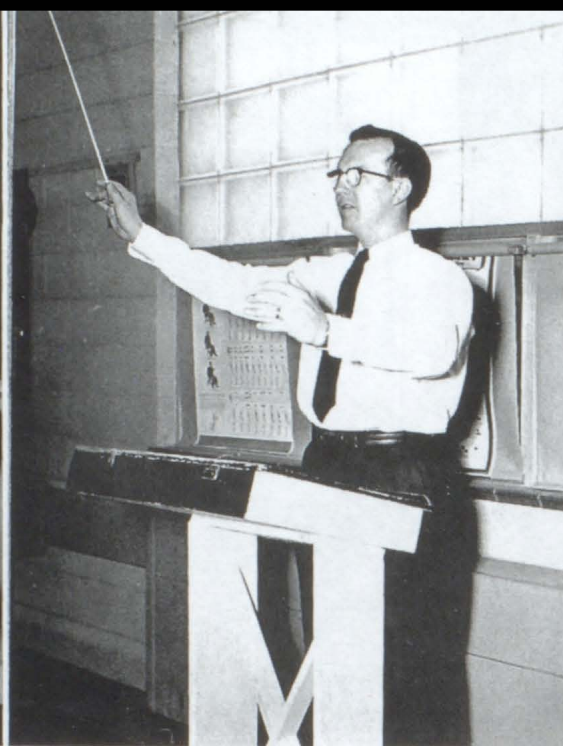
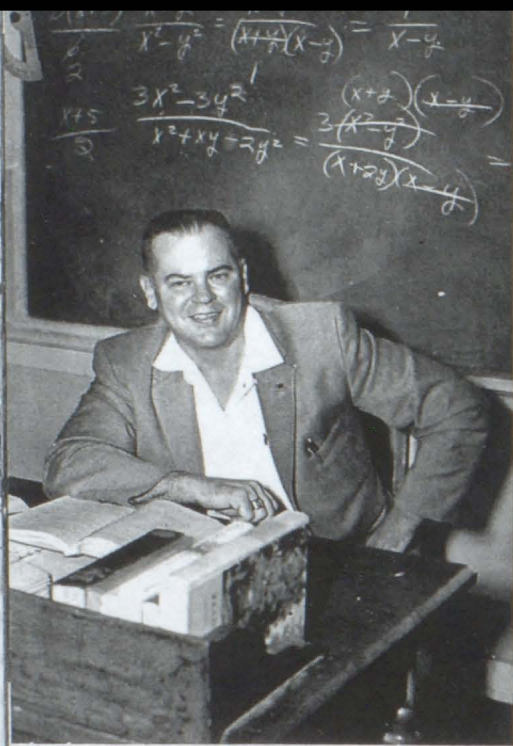




ENLARGED FACULTY TEACHES STUDENTS

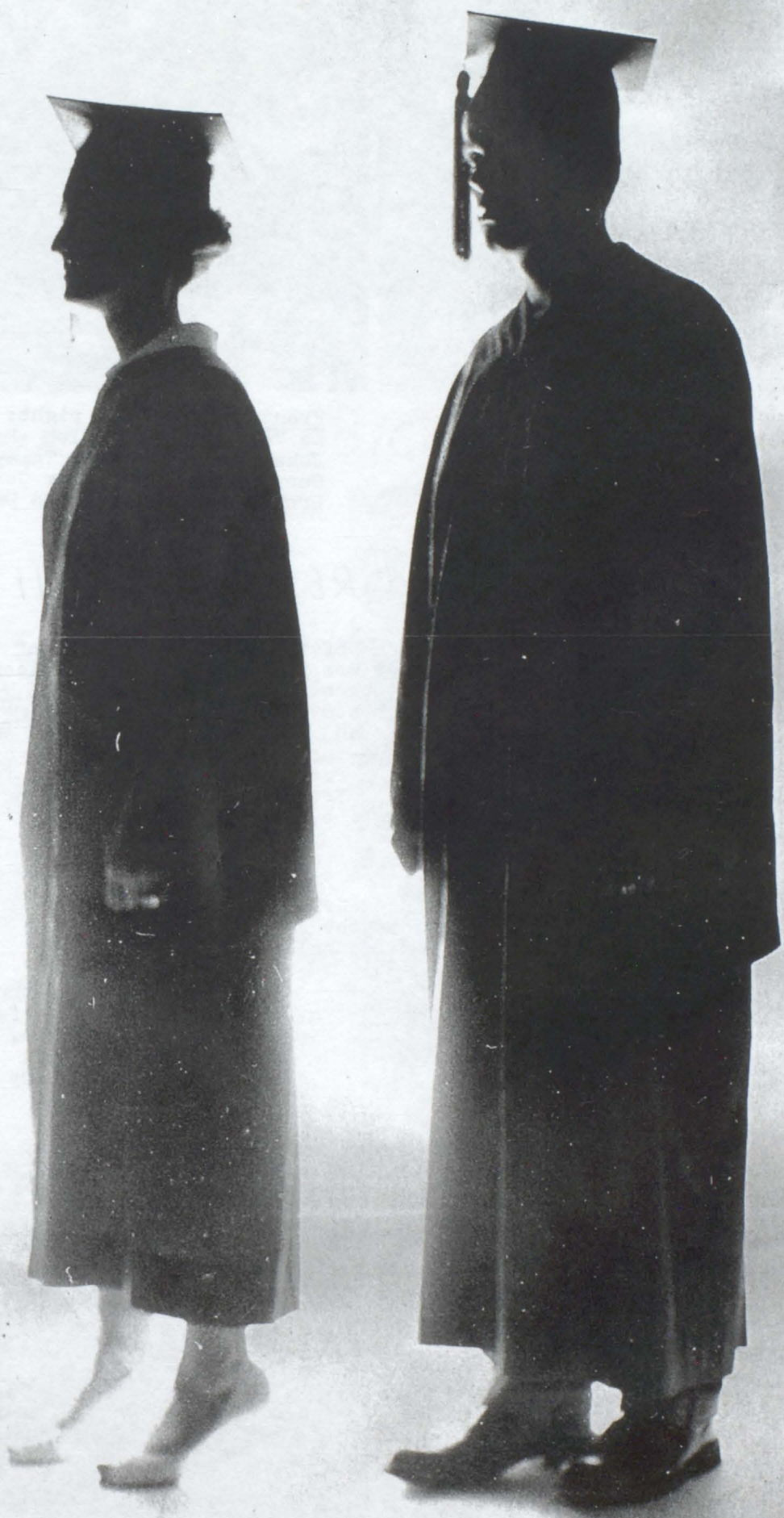

47 FRESHMEN INITIATED

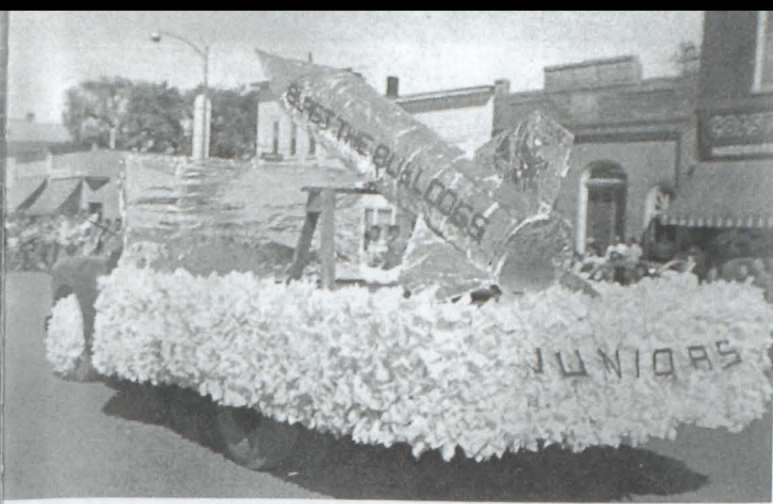

FOOTBALL TEAM HAS 3-4 RECORD

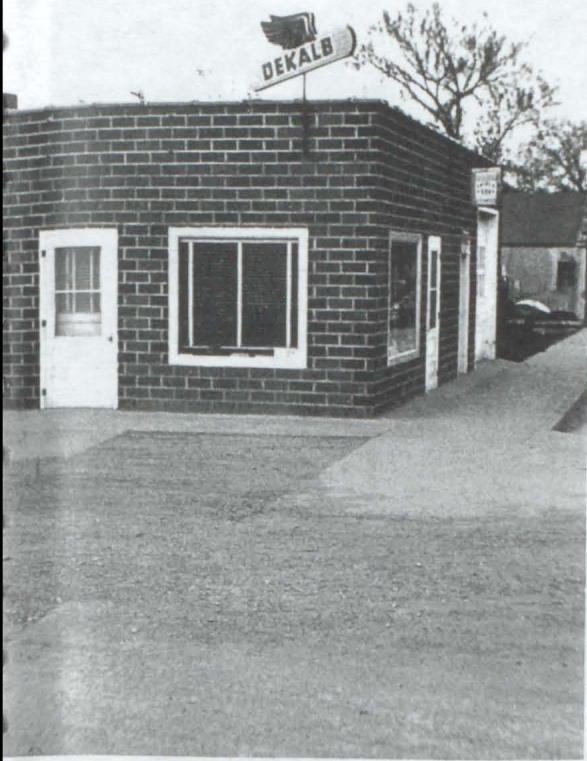

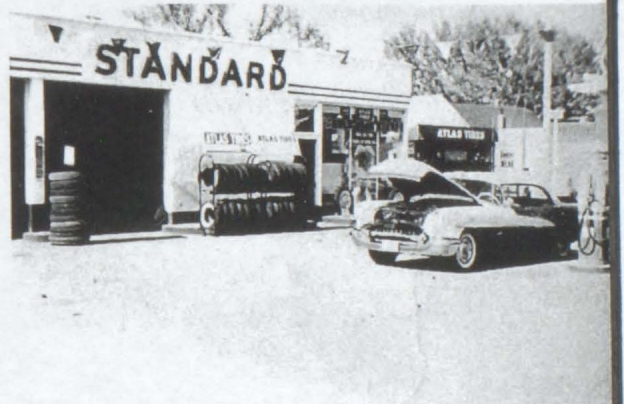
