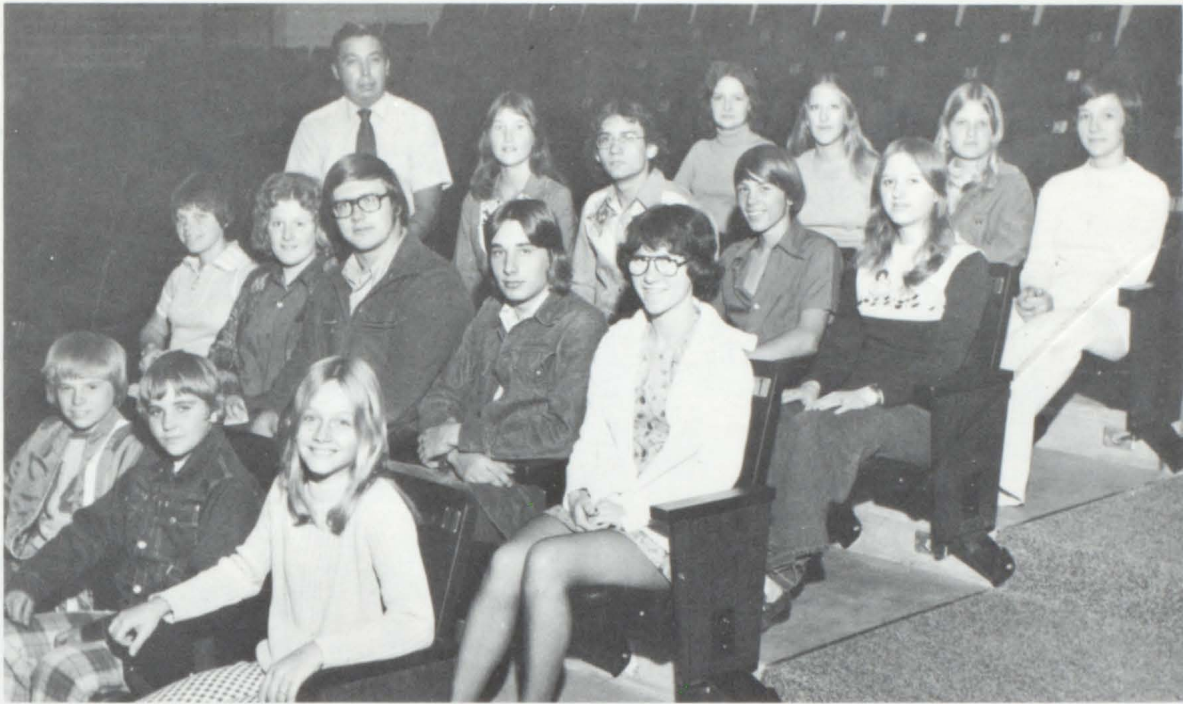

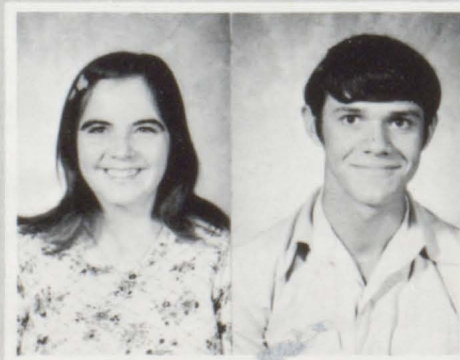
## SOPHOMORES

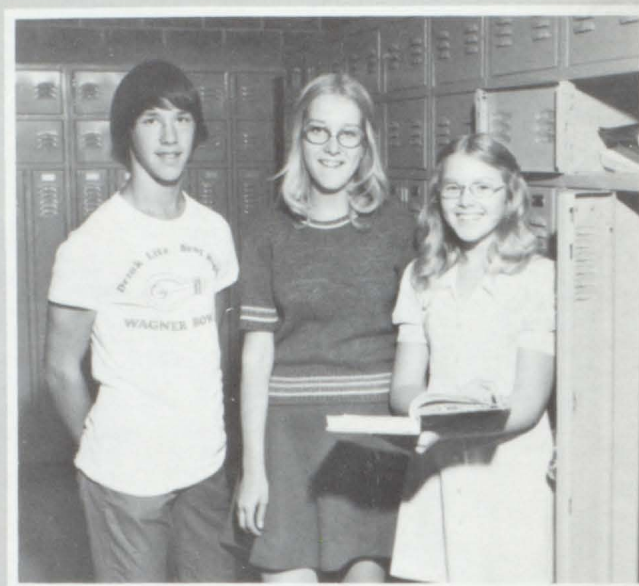




# FRESHMEN

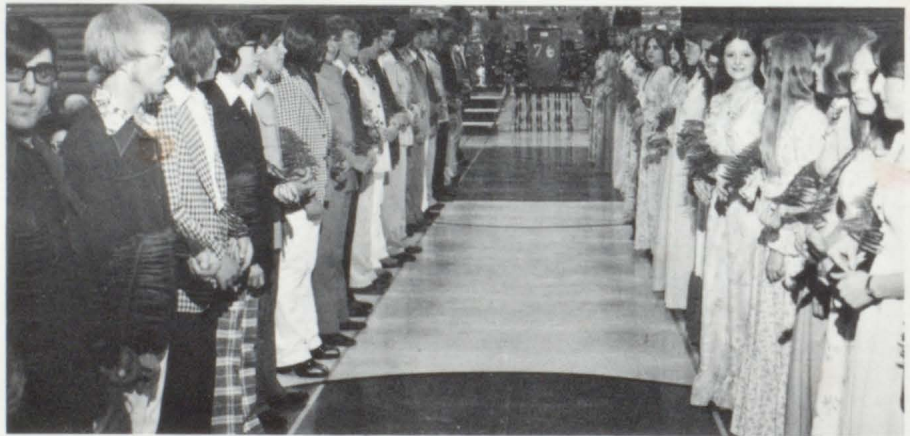
