





LIFE WITH MR. TWITERO





About two years after teaching here Mr. Twitero married Jan Stillman on November 20, 1966. They now have two children, Janelle and Shelley.



We the Annual Staff are proud of Mr. Twitero who is a very talented teacher. We would like to wish him the best of luck always.





The third quarter showed the defensive strengths of both teams. The Raiders had a couple of opportunities for a touchdown, but penalties and mistakes stopped them.


Early in the fourth quarter, Gregg Stedronsky launched a perfect pass, covering 25 yards to boost the score to 26-6.















