Since this is Mrs. Quinn's last year we hope good fortune follows her and that she has many good memories of WHS.







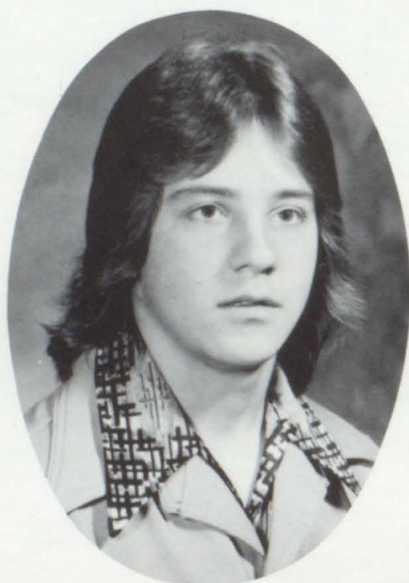

Friday night Wagner hosted Burke for the homecoming game. The stands were filled with excited fans. Both Wagner and Burke were undefeated going into the game.

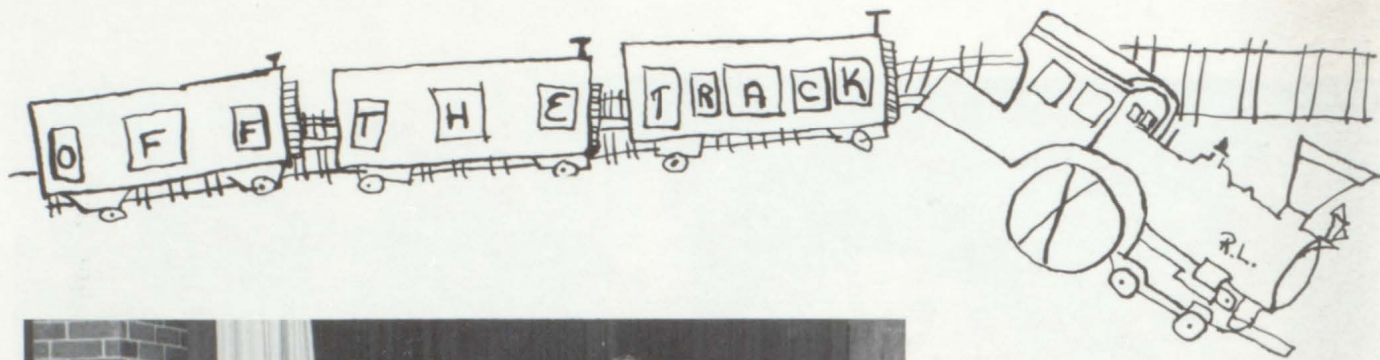
