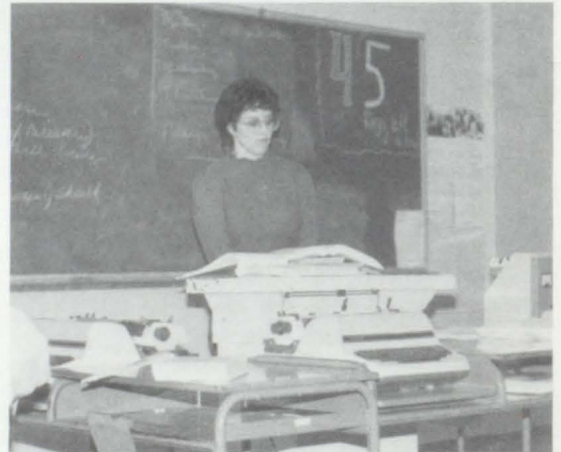
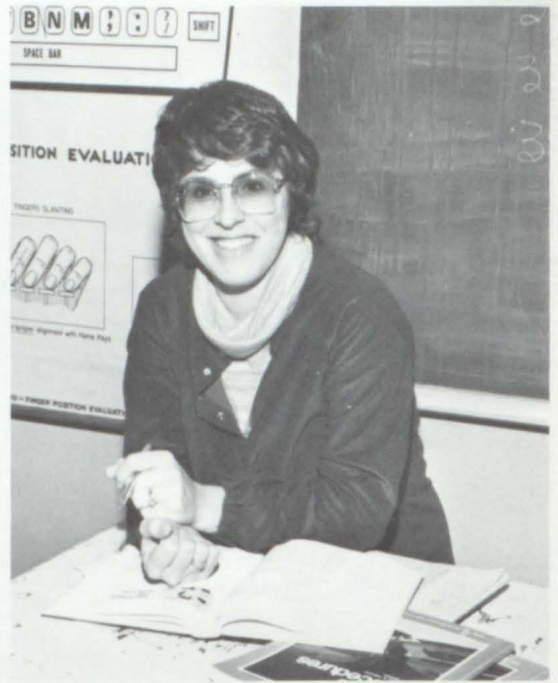
# Dedication

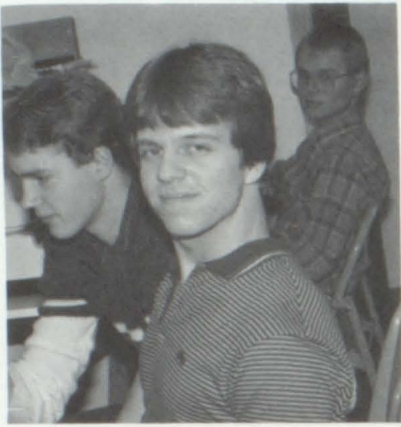
## *Homecoming '84*

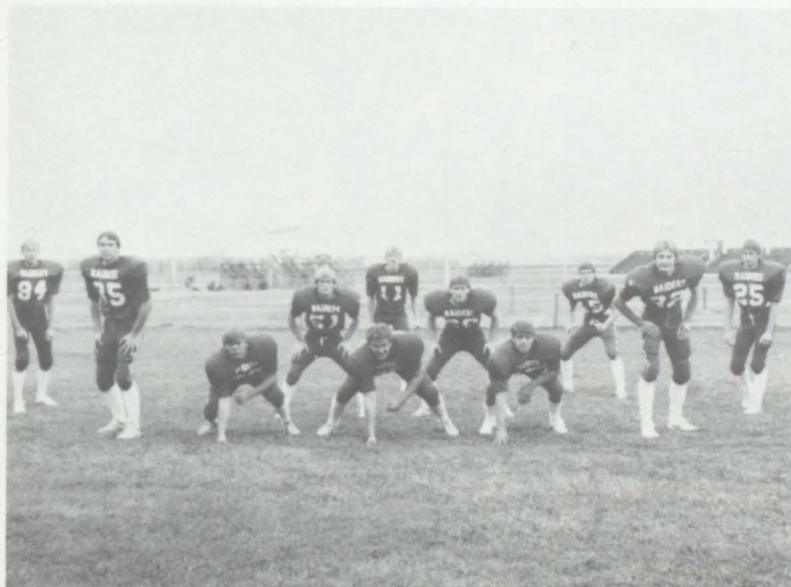
