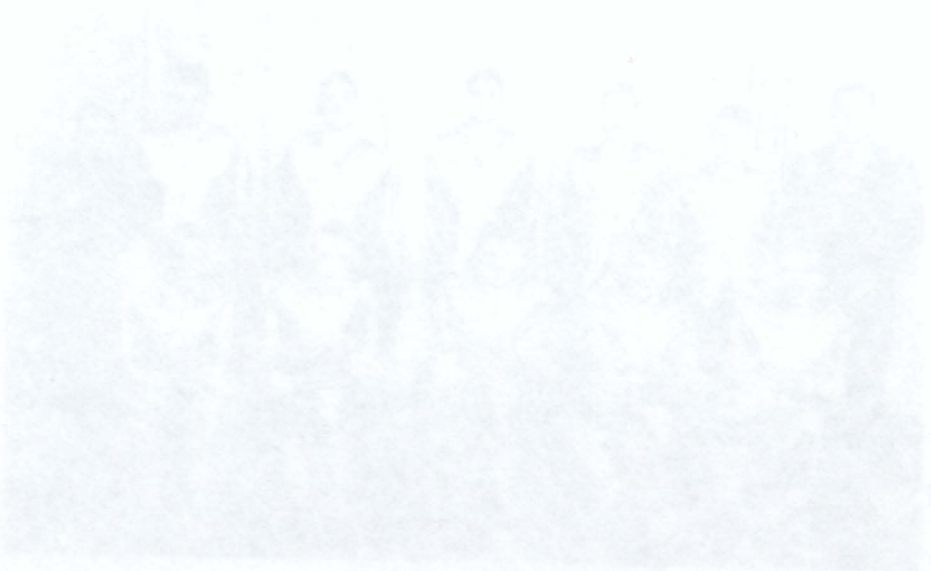
This schedule does not include invitational, district and regional tournaments.
