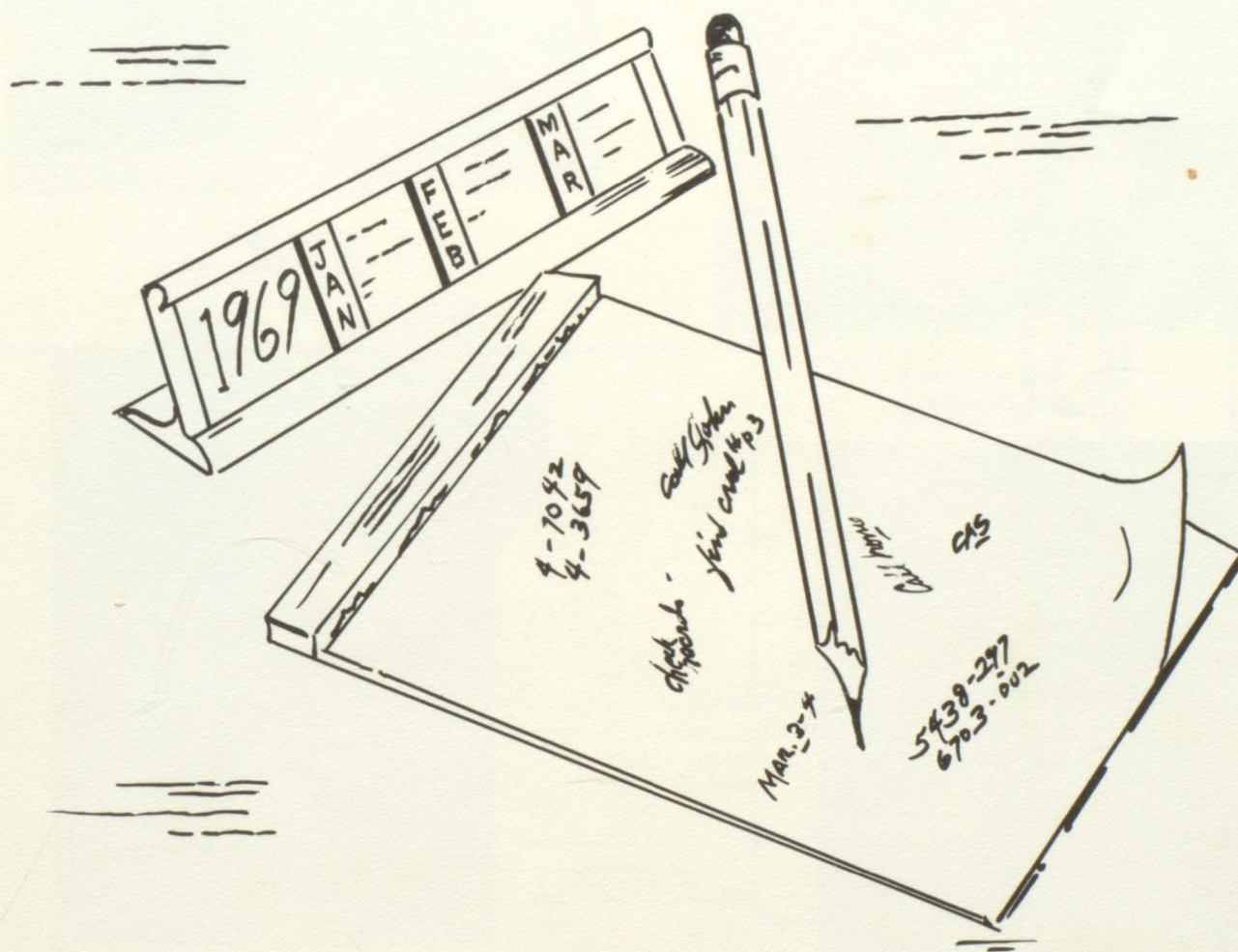
To our teacher and advisor, Mr. Dan Miller, the senior class of 1969 is proud to dedicate this Raider yearbook.

SENIOR CLASS HISTORY

The time, August, 1957. The place, Wagner Public Grade School. The purpose, enroll forty-eight six-year-olds as first graders. Their goal, to become a graduating class of Wagner High School. The time limit, twelve years, spring, 1969.

Eight years later, fall, 1965, a new experience was in store for sixty-six enthusiastic, bright-eyed, and green freshmen. It was found that twenty-one of the original class members in 1957 survived the trials and tribulations of grade school. Happily, the class also lived through the horrors of initiation and Kangaroo Court. To become an organized class, Greg Stulc was elected president; Doris Slaba, vice-president; Albert Soukup, secretary; and Tom Uecker, treasurer. Lottie Johnson transferred into our class. That year, Terry Zolnowsky led our class, with Terry Krsnak, vice-president; Terry Beeson, secretary; and Butch Weinstein, treasurer. Student Council representatives were Duane Kolda and Pat Metteer. Homecoming attendants were Charlene Bouska and Terry Krsnak. Mrs. Twitero and Mr. Koenig advised us.

The year of the "Jolly, Jolly Juniors" saw the loss of Dan Conger, Tim Doyle, Linda Giedd, Kevin Harrington, Lottie Johnson, Sherry Johnson, and Greg Stulc. Along with the new school name of East Charles Mix #102 came Curt Anderson, Janice Forman, Barb Gengler, LaVerne Hrdlicka, and Bob Deurmier. Under the leadership of Charlene Bouska, Rod McFarland, Greg Hoy, Dianne Weber, and Roxann Meyer, we made our prom, "Shower of Stars," a smashing success. Mr. Schoon, Mr. Miller, and Mrs. Johanssen gave us much attention as our advisors. Royalty attendants were Pat Anderson and Terry Zolnowsky. Delegates to Boys' State were Greg Hoy, Ron Payer, and LaVerne Hrdlicka, with Rod McFarland as alternate. Girls' Staters were Donna Frager and Rhonda Wiblemo, with alternates Roxann Meyer and Lois Blazek.

"We are mighty; we are fine; we're the class of '69!" This year we noted the loss of Greg Hoy, Randy Myers, and Barb Gengler. Class officers consisted of Rod McFarland, Pat Anderson, Pat Mach, and Ron Payer. Jane Zacharias and Butch Weinstin represented us in the Student Council. Candidates for King were Butch Weinstein, Terry Zolnowsky, and Terry Krsnak. Queen candidates were Pat Anderson, Charlene Bouska, and Jane Zacharias. Terry Zolnowsky and Charlene Bouska reigned as the 1968 Homecoming Royalty.

To complete the list of laurels won by the senior class, we must include the Honor Students: Lois Blazek, Charlene Bouska, Rhonda Wiblemo, Roxann Meyer, and Rod McFarland. Rhonda was also chosen as D.A.R. representative. Roxann won the Betty Crocker Homemaker award, and was also a National Merit Scholarship Finalist.
