The Wagner High School Concert and Marching Band, under the direction of Mr. Colin Olsen, has completed another successful year.

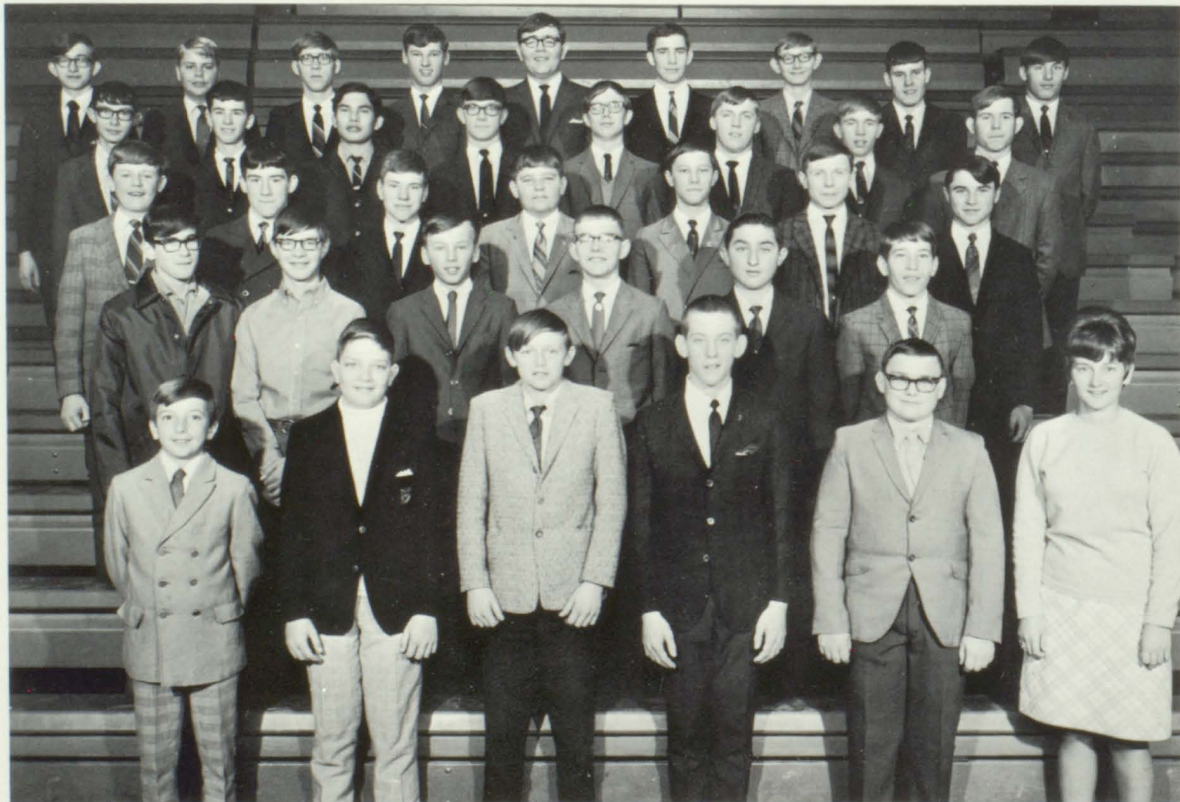
